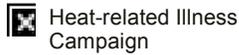

Market Report

Market Update:

Pine

The yellow pine market continues to be over-produced and items selling at lows for the calendar year. Because mills continue to struggle with breaking even, we do expect further production adjustments in the third quarter.

Panels

The panel markets are following similar trends. Also over-produced, these markets are trading at or near floor levels and demand is too weak to force prices upward.

Under current market conditions, production curtailments are necessary to strengthen pricing.

Mills will continue to evaluate production levels to manipulate price. An active hurricane season could result in short lived market appreciation.

Roofing

Although the initial surge of orders and industry shock seems to have settled, the supply/demand issue remains a significant problem and will continue for the foreseeable future. During the next few months, pricing will remain strong. I will not be surprised if we see another price increase announced for August/September. There are currently two price increases pending.

During the next 60-120 days, the level of stress on availability will depend heavily on the storm activity from the 2011 Hurricane Season. Lead times are three to six weeks (depending on allocation,
