Memorial Day

M&M Lumber will be closed Monday, May 25th in observance of Memorial Day. We will open Tuesday May 26th.

Roofing: The major roofing manufactures just implemented price increases. Owens Corning, May 1 5%. Atlas, May 1 5-7%. Tamko, May 5 5-7%. Malarkey, May 11 5-7%.

Rebar: The rebar market is soft and expected to remain soft. More import bar is expected to hit the ports in June.

Lumber, Plywood & Panels: Price increases are a constant from manufactures noting one reason or another for their increase. Surprisingly, the lumber market has not seen a price increase as one would expect for this time of year.

Most forecasters and past history tells us that lumber and panel prices would have rebounded by now, but that hasn't happened yet. Weather has played a big role in reducing the demand, as well as an increase in supply due to mills producing more lumber and plywood.

A couple of years ago when lumber and panel prices were high, many mills came out of their mothball status and went back into producing. These additional mills have put more production into the market than the current demand today. The supply and demand has shifted to an over supply market.

How long with this last? That's the thousand dollar question! If mills start curtailing production, which many experts are predicting, the supply and demand will start to balance and prices will reflect the larger demand. As of yet, this isn't the case though.

Other Vendors:

-Poly prices are expected to be on the rise over the next few weeks as it is suspected that it is at it bottom.
