Market Report:

Market Update:

Gypsum: the drywall market is soft with prompt shipment.



Roofing:

Tamko has discontinued a handful of colors in the Heritage Premium line (50 year shingle), as well as in their Heritage 30 line. Colors include forest green, harvest gold, oxford grey, painted desert, and rustic hickory in the Heritage Premium line. The Heritage 30 discontinued colors include driftwood, forest green, grey mist, and tile red. Tamko has announced a 7% price increase on all residential and commercial roofing

for those who were able to come see new products, install tricks, and ask questions direct to the manufactures. Here are a few photos from each event.

products effective July 1. Other manufactures are expected to follow.

Rebar: The rebar market has been steady without a lot of change in the last 30 days. Import bar is expected in late July or early August to help keep prices depressed.

Lumber: The lumber market has taken a short but quick turn and has seen some significant increases. The question is, will this be a change that will last or is it only a temporary position. It is hard to say without this weeks lumber report that will come out on Friday with current prices. The feel at mid week was that the price of the market would increase but not at the rate it has in the weeks prior. 2x4, 2x6, and 2x12 have all seen price increases, but the overall market is still lower than what it was last year at this time.

Plywood & Panels: The panel market is completely different when you compare it to the lumber market. We have not seen the abrupt increase that the lumber market has had and it appears to be in a much more stable position with all things considered.

Other Vendors:

-The poly and insulation markets are both steady. Neither are expected to change in the next few weeks.

-Streamlite flashlights took a 2% price increase the first of June.

-Norton took a 2-8% price increase effective June 20th.

-Linzer, a paint brush company will take a 3-8% price increase effective June 30th.

-Master Lock will implement a 3-5% price increase on locks effective July 1.

-Birdwell Cleaning Products will take a 3-5% price increase effective July 19th.




