Market Report:

Market Update:

Gypsum:

Price increases have been announced for January 1, 2018 by American Gypsum, CertainTeed, and National Gypsum. Price increases range 15-20%.



Roofing: Even with the storms that hit the US in August and September, roofing prices mostly remained unchanged. Surprisingly, lead times have remained 2-4 weeks as well.

Rebar: With August and September rebar prices creeping up, October and November prices have remained unchanged and steady. The market is still waiting on the ruling on Section 232, and it is expected that the market will remain unchanged through December.

Lumber & Panels: November 2, the US Department of Commerce announced the final determination in the countervailing and anti-dumping duty for lumber shipments from Canada to the US. Most Canadian lumber producers will pay 20.83% on lumber shipped to the US. This is down from the preliminary rate of 26.75%. Lumber prices, specifically cedar for us, have increased over the past year in part because of the duties placed on the Canadian manufactures.

OSB and most plywoods have dropped over the last few weeks. Treated pine still remains firm, along with 2x4 and 2x6 studs.

Other Vendors:

-Afco Millworks will take a 3-5% price increase December 4th.

-Senco Nails will take a price increase ranging from 2-8% December 1 due to the cost of global steel and transportation costs.

-Larson Storm doors will take a 4-5% price increase January 8, 2018 citing increased operations costs.

-Metal Sales, the manufacture of metal siding, has announced 2% increased fuel surcharges effective December 12.

-Magnolia Brush has sent out their annual price increase letter...Effective January 1, they will take a price increase citing increased raw material and packaging costs.

-DW Distribution has announced price increases on Masonite doors effective November 6. These include their interior doors, moulded doors, steel exterior doors, and fiberglass doors. Endura door components also took a price increase November 6th.

-Simpson Strong-Tie has announced a price increase for January 1, 2018.

-ODL Door glass inserts will take a 4% price increase January 1, 2018.

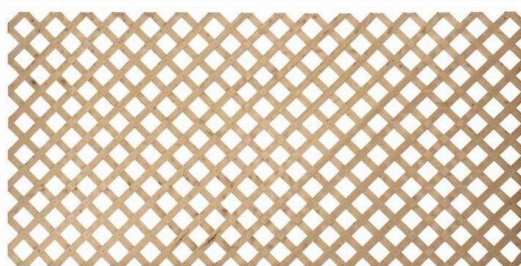
