## Market Report:

Market Update:

<u>Gypsum:</u> Not much change in the Gypsum market since our February e-newsletter. The market status continues to be is steady.



<u>Roofing:</u> Roofing prices remain steady. Owens Corning has taken a price increase of 7% on March 1. CertainTeed and GAF have announced price increases from 8-10% for April 1. Tamko has announced a price increase of 7-9% effective May 1. CertainTeed's Norwood plan is no longer on strike, and production is resuming. Tamko out of Dallas, Joplin, and Tuscaloosa are all on allocation. Lead times are extended.

With oil prices on the sharp increase, roofing will continue to rise.

<u>Rebar</u>: The rebar market is steady. Scrap metal has taken a small decrease but is now stable with upward pressures. There is a quite a bit of import bar coming into the ports that may keep the prices from rising. We do not expect a large swing either up or down in rebar prices in the next 60 days.

<u>Lumber:</u> Lumber prices are on the rise. Demand is modestly better than it was at this time last year. Mild weather is getting some of the credit for this, as well as a modest uptick in housing starts. Purchasing by offshore markets remain steady.

<u>Plywood:</u> Plywood and OSB have both taken a price increase in the last few weeks. OSB in the south has taken the smallest price increase when compared to the

wall bracing requirements of the 2009 International Residential Code. the class is Wednesday, March 21, 2012. For more information, see the attached flyer: Wall Brace Workshop

#### From the Wood Pile:

New Southern Pine Design Values Effective June 1, 2012 The Southern Pine Inspection Bureau (SPIB) has issued 'Supplement No. 9 to the 2002 Standard grading Rules for Southern Pine Lumber' providing new design values effective June 1, 2012.

The only design values that will change on June 1 apply to visually graded Southern Pine and Mixed Southern Pine sized 2" to 4" wide and 2" to 4" thick (2x2 through 4x4s) in No. 2 and lower grades (No. 2, No. 3, Construction, Standard and Utility). Design values for all other grades and sizes of visually graded Southern Pine remain the same, pending results of later testing in 2012.

The effective date of June 1 allows for an orderly transition to the new design values. The intent of the six-month transition period is to allow the marketplace to begin to use the new design northern and eastern markets. Many panels have jumped \$1-\$1.50 or more a sheet. Good weather across the country has allowed inventory to flow.

As the price of crude oil has increased dramatically over the past few weeks and the price for diesel fuel and gasoline continues to spike, several manufacturers of construction materials have indicated they plan to implement a fuel surcharge on all orders beginning in March. The fuel surcharge that many manufacturers will charge will be between 3 and 5% of the face value of their invoices. Also, the fuel surcharge which freight carriers charge has increased substantially over the past 30 days and the higher freight costs will affect prices for most construction materials over the next several months. Be sure that you get a current quote on all construction materials when you are bidding jobs as prices for most items will be higher than the last time you purchased them due to the higher cost of freight.


