Market Report:

Market Update:

Gypsum: The gypsum market has been pretty quiet with no real changes. Lead times from manufacturing is prompt.

Roofing: Roofing demand remains strong. Allocation and lead times still affect the roofing market of most all the major manufactures with various products.



Rebar: With the yo-yo affect of steal prices so far this year, what would make us think it

will change? So far it's not...for now though, the prices are down slightly for both remesh and rebar.

<u>Lumber & Panels</u>: Since July 4th, the lumber market has had a slight uptick but is currently stable and has found its trading range with a slight pullback in pricing. All indications point to an increase in building this fall with increases in material demand. Volatility should be less than the last two years' extreme price fluctuations as the mills control the material available into the market.

The panel market is a bit elevated over our long-term average with a little uptick in pricing as of late. A fire at the Huber mill in Broken Bow, OK caused some uncertainty in Zip panels and Advantech but the fire was not as bad as originally anticipated. Supply is available but the mills are controlling the outflow of product and therefore setting the price.

Wildfires in Canada have burned 9.2 million hectares of forest with another month or two before cooler and wetter weather is expected.

With inventory of existing homes for sale becoming thin, construction is expected to pick up. The combination of rising demand and reduced supply could increase lumber prices in the foreseeable future.

In its recent ruling, the DOC determined that "imports of certain hardwood plywood products (hardwood plywood), completed in the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (Vietnam) using plywood inputs and components (face veneer, back veneer, and/or either an assembled core or individual core veneers) manufactured in the People's Republic of China (China), are circumventing the antidumping duty and countervailing duty orders on hardwood plywood from China". These certain plywoods are subject to antidumping duties and countervailing duties. (Source: Floor Daily)

- T-111 is still a few weeks out at best. This has been on order for over a month but none is available in either 4" or 8" till mid- September.


